White Wines

Turning Leaf White Zinfandel, California \$15

Light bodied with bright flavors of strawberries and melon.

Soave Bolla, Italy \$18

This is a very ripe style of Soave with a honey, apple pie and cream character throughout. Full-bodied, opulent & impressive.

San Angelo Pinot Grigio, Italy \$29

DOCG. Estate bottled, Single vineyard. Intense, fruity aroma, followed by a clean refreshing taste - the characteristics that distinguish this unique and aristocratic Tuscan Pinot Grigio from its northern counterparts.

Masi Masianco \$23

The wine has a pleasant straw-yellow color. The intense bouquet is characterized by pineapple, banana, acacia flowers and honey. A good floral and citrus freshness balances the full and creamy palate.

Maso Canali Pinot Grigio, Italy \$26

The pinnacle of Pinot Grigio! A labor-intensive Passito method is used to deliver a unique taste profile. This creates a wine with riper fruit flavors than most Pinot Grigios, intense tropical fruit, and a fuller, rounder mouth-feel.

Santa Margherita Pinot Grigio, Italy \$37

A dry fruity and well balanced white wine.

Rancho Zabaco Russian River Sauvignon Blanc \$25

Aromas of boxwood, fresh cut grass, lime peel, lemongrass and sweet pea are matched with flavors of grapefruit and passion fruit.

Whitehaven Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, NZ \$30

This light straw, lemon-lime colored wine with gooseberry aromas & hints of ripe citrus. Full flavored, medium bodied, gooseberry with a clean lingering finish.

Simi Chardonnay, Sonoma County \$35

Brilliantly clear, with a golden straw color. Lush, creamy texture enhanced by citrus notes and flavors of pear, apricot and tropical fruit. Hints of vanilla and oak that carry through to a long, lingering finish.

Falcor Chardonnay, Napa Valley

\$45

A bouquet of butterscotch and tangerines, with mineral characteristics. A Burgundian style wine with toasty oak notes, good acidity with flavors of ripe apples and pears.

J. Simonin "Ammonites" Burgundy France

\$57

Produced from 60-year old vines, vinified and aged in American Oak. Which puts a new twist on a medium-bodied, concentrated, silky-textured wine that is packed with mineral-laced pear flavors. Brilliantly clear, with a golden straw color.

Champagne & Sparkling Wines

Maschio Prosecco, Italy

\$23

A soft, semi-sparkling white, with a lively mousse. Light gold in color, with a bouquet of aromatic fruit and a hint of musk. Soft taste, with an elegant finish of candied fruit. It pairs extremely well with seafood appetizers, grilled white meats, and salads.

Vietti Moscato Di Asti, Italy

\$25

From the village of Castiglione comes the crisp and bright style of Italian sparkling wine that works well as an aperitif or for dessert! Sweet and fruity find flavors of candied green apples pears and more!

Martini & Rossi Asti Spumante, Italy

\$23

100% Moscato grapes from Italy's prestigious Asti region. Apricot and honey flavors give life to this sweet sparkling wine.

Vve Fourny & Fils Grand Reserve Brut

\$55

From the Cote de Blancs area or Champagne, a Premier Cru, with 80% Chardonnay and 20% Pinot Noir. Produced from a tiny Estate with production of 10,000 cases. A wonderful value on a classy Champagne.

Vve Fourny & Fils Brut Rose

\$62

From the Cote de Blancs area or Champagne, a Premier Cru, with 100 Pinot Noir left on the skins long enough to color the wine. Produced from a tiny Estate with production of 10,000 cases. A wonderful value on a classy Champagne, slightly tart and crisp.

Red Wines

McMurray Ranch Pinot Noir, Sonoma Coast \$29

Expressive fruit character, exhibiting rich aromas of red, blue and black fruits, with cherry, ripe blueberries and dark current. The flavors are melded together with earthy notes, balanced perfectly with the nuance of soft vanilla from the oak aging.

Whitehaven Pinot Noir, Marlborough, New Zealand \$42

This wine has a deep ruby hue & dense tone. Taste for rich plum and bottled cherry fruit flavours, lifted by spicy, cherry oak and underlined by a gamey complexity. A full-bodied wine with a soft, velvet texture and a firm, lingering finish.

Chateau Germain Pinot Noir, Burgundy \$36

100% Pinot Noir from the grapes origins! Estate grown, made and bottled from 70 year old vines at the Chateau. Ruby colours, with bold berries n cherries.

Falcor Pinot Noir, Russian River Valley \$45

Pleasing Fruit aromas and flavors of black cherry and ripe plum complemented with earthy notes of mushroom and sweet tannins.

Alois Lageder Pinot Noir, Italy \$32

Medium intense ruby colour with a garnet shimmer. Impressions of red berry fruit, cherries along with oak spice (white pepper, cinnamon). Medium bodied. Fresh finish with good length and a presence of spicy tannin.

Toasted Head Merlot \$24

This wine displays a deep red color tinged with ruby-red reflections. It is soft and lovely in the modern red style, with aromas of well-ripened blackberry fruit with a slightly earthy note.

Blackstone Merlot, California \$22

From the company that made merlot popular, attractive aromas of vanilla and toasted chestnuts wrapped around bright cherry, ripe raspberry and exotic spice with a supple elegant finish.

Greg Norman Cabernet Merlot \$29

A perfect partner for food, this Cabernet dominant blend contributes rich mulberry and spicy tannins with the merlot adding cherry currant & smooth blueberry.

Davinci Chianti, Italy DOCG

\$23

This purple-red wine possesses spicy, cedary oak aromas of black cherries and dark plum fruit. It is well balanced, medium to full bodied wine, ripe with flavors of plum, black cherries and dark fruit.

Val delle Rose Morellino Di Sansano Riserva, Italy

\$35

DOCG, Estate Bottled, 100% Sangiovese, Intense ruby red. Richly perfumed nose with black-cherry aromas and hints of vanilla. The wine is complex, harmonious and well structured.

Cecchi "Bonizio" Sangiovese, Tuscany

\$23

Newly sourced from Maremma this Sangiovese is a crowd pleaser that best suits red sauces. It is pleasing on the palate and one of the more popular wines on our list.

Cecchi Spargola

\$49

IGT, Estate Bottled, Elegant yet earthy. A Super Tuscan with black fruit, tobacco, and chestnut flavors. Great structure and a persistent finish.

Banfi Chianti Classico, Tuscany

\$24

DOCG, Estate bottled, An enduring classic: alluring bouquet of black fruit and violets; rich flavors of cherry and leather; supple tannins and good acidity for dining.

Banfi Chianti Riserva, Tuscany

\$32

DOCG Estate Bottled, Produced from select grapes grown in the "Classico" region of Chianti, this dry, fruity and well-balanced red has a full bouquet reminiscent of violets.

Castello Banfi Rosso di Montalcino, Tuscany

\$45

DOC, Estate Bottled, Brunello's "younger brother," produced from select Sangiovese grapes and aged in barrique for 10 to 12 months. Deep ruby-red, elegant, vibrant, well-balanced and stylish with a dry velvety finish.

Castello Banfi Brunello di Montalcino, Tuscany

\$87

Rich, round, velvety and intensely aromatic, with flavor hints of licorice, cherry, and spices. Brunello di Montalcino possesses an intense ruby-red color, and a depth, complexity and opulence that is softened by an elegant, lingering aftertaste.

Mandrielle Merlot, Tuscany

\$65

DOC, Single Vineyard, Estate bottled. Intense, richly complex and harmonious with a soft, seductive character. Barrique-aged in French oak for twelve months

Sartori Amarone delle Valpolicella Classico, Veneto **\$55**

The aristocrat of Verona - robust, full-bodied and dry with excellent balance and a velvety finish.

Centine Rosso di Toscana ("Chen-TEEN-ay") **\$23**

A Super Tuscan blend of Sangiovese, Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot vinified in a firm, round style that easily accompanies a wide range of dishes. A smooth and fragrantly satisfying wine with international character.

Falcor Cabernet, Napa **\$60**

An elegant balance of ripe black fruit and well integrated tannins. Muscular and age-worthy!

Cum Laude, Tuscany **\$47**

DOC Estate bottled, Sangiovese, Cabernet, Syrah. A complex, elegant, and harmonious cuvée which graduated "With Honors." Characterized by aromas of juicy berries and fresh spices. Unfiltered to retain subtle nuances.

Summus, Tuscany **\$89**

DOC Estate bottled, A wine of towering elegance, Summus is an extraordinary cuvée of Sangiovese which contributes structure; Cabernet Sauvignon, fruit and body; and Syrah, character, spice, and a fruity bouquet.

Tavernelle Cabernet Sauvignon **\$73**

DOC, Single Vineyard, Estate Bottled. An intense, velvety red wine with a fruity bouquet that hints of vanilla and a full-bodied taste that finishes with spice and anise tones.

Rancho Zabaco Zinfandel, California **\$25**

This wine is bright, zesty and bursting with flavors of black cherry and berries.

Terrunyo Carmenere. Chile **\$53**

Single Vineyard, Full-bodied red that hints of chocolate, pepper, cigar box and spice.

Zen of Zin (Ravenswood Winery) **\$30**
